This is the **1st day of the 2nd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **8th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Genesis 17:10-12

*(10) **This is my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised.***

*(11) **And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you.***

*(12) **And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which is not of thy seed.***

Deuteronomy 10:12-16

*(12) **And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,***

*(13) **To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?***

*(14) **Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is the LORD'S thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is.***

*(15) **Only the LORD had a delight in thy fathers to love them, and he chose their seed after them, even you above all people, as it is this day.***

*(16) **Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked.***

This is the **2nd day of the 2nd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **9th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Jeremiah 4:3-4

(3) For thus saith the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns.

(4) Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.

Ezekiel 18:30-31,23,32

(30) Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin.

(31) Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?

(23) Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?

(32) For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith the Lord GOD: wherefore turn yourselves, and live ye.

Lamentations 3:33

it is the **10th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Ezekiel 11:19-21

(19) And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:

(20) That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

(21) But as for them whose heart walketh after the heart of their detestable things and their abominations, I will recompense their way upon their own heads, saith the Lord GOD.

Psalms 51:10,16-17

(10) Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

(16) For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering.

(17) The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.

Psalms 147:3,5

Jeremiah 24:7

(7) And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

Mark 16:11-14

(11) And they, when they had heard that he was alive, and had been seen of her, believed not.

(12) After that he appeared in another form unto two of them, as they walked, and went into the country.

(13) And they went and told it unto the residue: neither believed they them.

(14) Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

Luke 24:45-47

(45) Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

(46) And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

Ezekiel 36:26-28

(26) A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

(27) And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

(28) And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

Jeremiah 32:38-39

(38) And they shall be my people, and I will be their God:

(39) And I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them:

Deuteronomy 5:29

(29) O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever!

as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Ezekiel 18:21-23

(21) But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

(22) All his transgressions that he hath committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he hath done he shall live.

(23) Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?

Deuteronomy 30:6

(6) And the LORD thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.

2 Peter 3:9

(9) The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

(4) Who can bring a clean thing out of an unclean? not one.

Proverbs 20:9
